Welcome to our very special September Anniversary Celebration for the ISA. Our founder, Amanda Flower, established our organization 100 years ago in 1924.

We will be gathering at The Spiritualist First Church of Truth, (affectionately known as the Mother Church) in Grand Rapids Michigan for our 100th Convention on September 13^{th,} through the 15th, 2024.

The Spiritualist First church of Truth The address of the church is 127 Meerse Street S.E. Grand Rapids, Mi. 49507 "All are Welcome."

A little history on why the ISA was born and about The Rev. Amanda Flower: The Independent Spiritualist Association of the United States of America (ISA) was founded in 1924 by Rev. Amanda Flower.

At the time She was a Reverend, Healer, and Medium with the National Spiritualist Association of Churches (NSAC). What happened is that Rev. Flower had acquired beliefs that were not in line with NSAC doctrine.

A noticeable belief not consistent with NSAC was reincarnation. By this time, she was well versed on *Madam Blavatsky work involving reincarnation and Madame Blavatsky theosophical teachings.

Rev. Flower also did not subscribe to the idea with NSAC that certified mediums <u>could not</u> do their mediumship work in public venues but only in NSAC churches. Furthermore, they <u>could not</u> work in churches that were not NSAC churches. Because of this, and her overall dissatisfaction with the restrictions of NSAC, she decided to create the Independent Spiritualist Association of the United States of America. (ISA) The Purpose of the ISA – "Togetherness with Independence". In 1924, Amanda Flower felt the need of an organization that would promote Spiritualism and let churches group together for protection and strength; yet still give the individual churches the freedom to worship in their way.

With this thought in mind, she became the founder of the "Independent Spiritualist Association of the United States of America. The organization has grown in membership in several states and gained worldwide recognition. It still maintains the purpose for which it was founded... "Togetherness with Independence." You can find Rev. Amanda Cameron Flower (1863-1940) Graveside-Grand Rapids Michigan.

*Helena Petrovna Blavatsky (1831-1891) a.k.a. Madame Blavatsky, was a Russian and American <u>mystic.</u> She was an author who co-founded the Theosophical Society in 1875.

*She gained an international following as the leading authority of Theosophy.

*Through Madame Blavatsky work, it allowed *theoreticians* to turn their attention to the portion of the universe that remained unexplained, as well as the esoteric concepts, such as, the possibility of parallel universes. Rev. Flower's mentor, Madame Blavatsky continues to have foundational influence in the ISA even today, through our founder Rev. Amanda Flower.
